### SUBMISSION OF PAPERS

Papers must be written in English and extended summary should be electrically received on HEALTHCOM2005 website (<http://www.healthcom2005.org>) by March 5, 2005. The extended summary is to be limited to a maximum length of 3 pages including figures, tables and references (IEEE format: A4 size, single space, double column and Time Roman of font size 10). All submitted papers will be reviewed by International experts in the Program Committee.

The full paper is to be limited to a maximum length of 10 pages of the same format as extended summary. Both the extended summary and the full paper must have the names, affiliations, email addresses and full contact details of all authors. The accepted papers will be published in the workshop statement "All necessary clearances for the publication of this paper have been obtained".

### IMPORTANT DATES

- March 5, 2005 : Submission of extended summary
- April 5, 2005 : Notification of acceptance
- May 15, 2005 : Submission of camera-ready papers
- May 20, 2005 : Early-registration
- June 23, 2005 : Conference date

At least one of the authors of each accepted paper must register for the event within the registration deadline for the paper to be included in the proceedings.

### AWARDS

The International Program Committee will select the best research paper and the best young scientist (student) paper for awards.

### VENUE

The conference will be held at Haeundae Grand Hotel in Busan, Korea.
